### Educator Announces House Seat Run

Sheryl Williams, an educator and community activist, announced she will seek the Democratic nomination to the state House District 19 seat in Albuquerque.

The incumbent in the seat, state Rep. Bob Hawk, D-Albuquerque, has said he will not seek re-election this year.

Williams is vice principal at the Albuquerque Public Schools Career Enrichment Center and vice chair of the state Democratic Party. She is a founding member of the Charlie Morrissey Scholarship Committee and the Southeast (Heights) Gang Intervention and Prevention Task Force.

Williams is president of the Duke City Business and Professional Women's group. She has worked for APS for 10 years.
